BE OPEN MINDED

Scholarship opportunities are available locally, regionally and nationally. The more open you are to various areas of study, location and size of school...the greater the options.

BE ELIGIBLE

Rules have been defined by the NCAA which each player must follow to ensure academic eligibility in order to compete in college.

BE ORGANIZED

Finding the right college for each student can be a challenge and then factor in playing college golf... be thoughtful in your approach and communicate effectively with college coaches. They want the best person/ player just like you want the best school/program.
